

Disability assessment and certification process (Law 104/92)



1

Go to the pediatrician or general practitioner and claim the issue of a referral for a specialist examination.



2

Use the medical referral to book an appointment for the specialist examination at the ASL.



3

Undergo the examination by the ASL specialist, who will issue a medical report.



4

Hand over the medical report to the certifying doctor who fills out the Introductory Medical Certificate, submits it online to the INPS and gives you a copy. This officially starts the disability assessment process.

The certificate is valid for 90 days



5

Submit a copy of the Introductory Medical Certificate to the school.



6

Wait for the notification letter from the INPS Medical Commission with the examination date.

examination date within 30 days from the submission of the Introductory Medical Certificate



7

Undergo the examination by the Medical Commission. Don't forget to bring with you:

- **Introductory medical certificate** (see point 5);
- **Any other health documentation** relevant to the assessment;
- A **valid ID** of the minor.



8

Wait for the examination report from the Medical Commission

9

Submit the examination report (Invalidity and Law 104/92) to the school administration office and other administrative offices

*In case of an unsuccessful outcome due to non-recognition of the disability/invalidity status, it is possible to file an appeal in court against INPS within 180 days of the notification of the medical report.
